

Spanish as a foreign language

Method: I teach in Spanish from the beginning, if you need to use English in class it will not be a problem but I usually encourage my students to speak in Spanish from the very beginning, it is fun!

Levels

Beginners: Learn all the basics and speak from the first day! You will learn how to pronounce words, talk about yourself and about others, express your likes and dislikes, to talk about your daily life and the place where you live and describe your country, your plans for the future and your experiences.

Intermediate: Review the basics and improve what you know while you learn new things! In this course you will also learn, for example, how to talk to the doctor, to talk about what you are doing, your aims, your past and you will know a bit more about Spanish and Latin American culture. You will be able to describe things that happened to you and how to interact in an Spanish environment.

Advanced: Improve and practice what you know and learn much more! Here we will pay attention at what you need to improve, and also you will be able to talk about, for example, your dreams or things that could possibly happened in the future. There will be more grammar and more literature to understand a bit deeper our culture.

In addition to the courses above mentioned, I also offer thematic courses, "Cinema for you" and "You are music", where we will work from a Spanish or Latin American movie or song different aspects of the language and culture.

Spanish through movies and music

These courses are aimed to any student willing to know more about Spanish and Latin American culture.

Level: it is necessary to have a basic knowledge of Spanish to enjoy it fully.

It will consist of:

- Some previous exercises before the movie or song,
- Watching the movie (not entirely) or listening to a song while looking for specific information to be able to talk about it later.
- After the movie, exercises and round up ideas for cultural awareness.
